PREPARING FOR CONTAINER DELIVERY

DECIDE ON CONTAINER TYPE

Please see page 4 for container types and dimensions.

NOTE : Do you have high value for material, consider an enclosed container?

DECIDE ON THE AREA WHERE THE SKIP WILL BE BEST PLACED

All containers must be kept in a secure area that is clear of debris and obstructions. Please make sure there is space for the vehicle to drop the container safely.

NOTE : We cannot place containers on public roads.

AVOIDING HAZARDS

Avoid placing containers under overhead hazards such as power lines. Avoid busy areas, such as pedestrian walkways and exits. Containers must be dropped on stable, level, hard ground in a well-lit area.

DO'S & DON'T'S

DURING CONTAINER DELIVERY / COLLECTION

- DO NOT position containers on slopes, as the vehicle could tip sideways when loading.
- DO give the driver clear directions on where to place the container.
- DO NOT use container locks or doors, unless authorized by Maxilead. Please note container doors could be heavy and present a trap risk.
- DO maintain clear access for container delivery and removal at all times.
- DO NOT attempt to move the container once it has been placed. If the container does need moving, please contact the Maxilead team who will attend site at their earliest convenience.



CONTENTS OF THE CONTAINER

- DO NOT overfill or overload your container. Material must not project higher than container sides and must be under the max weight load limit detailed on page 4.
- DO place heavy items towards the rear of the container at floor level but not against the door.
- DO NOT allow fires within any container.
- DO ensure material contained will not move during transit.
- DO NOT load long lengths across the top of the container unless the ends are below the sides as they could slide off in transit.
